While The Polish Boxer starts like a classical campus novel in which a literature professor is talking about different authors and his concept of literature, later visiting an interdisciplinary Mark Twain conference in the United States, the focus shifts completely to questions of identity when he meets the pianist Rakic, who is rejecting his Serbian The Polish Boxer and wants to become a Gypsy since he is of mixed origin, he is shunned by both communities. He goes to a Mark Twain conference in North Carolina and feels judged and still he is equally aware that this romantic notion is incomplete and that coherence and narrative are inventions of literature that have little in common with everyday life.
